Program Overview:

Lorain County Community College's Right Skills Now program is focused on providing the knowledge and skills necessary for employment as a CNC Mill or Lathe Operator. This fast-track training program is designed for students to obtain high-quality manufacturing jobs; it has two nationally recognized credentials embedded into the program:

National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC),

National Institute of Metal Working Skills (NIMS)

The technical training program is blended with credit and non-credit coursework. The part-time evening program will be delivered in 3 semesters. Once students successfully complete all the technical training the 3rd semester will consist of a 12 week, part-time paid internship with one of our local industry partners. Eligibility requirements apply.

Classes are taught at Lorain County JVS in Oberlin, Ohio by LCCC faculty. LCCC's coursework combines lecture and hands-on application. Financial Assistance may be available to those who qualify with OhioMeansJobs-Lorain County and Federal Student Aid.
